



# Position Description – Club Captains

## Overview of Role

Our Club Captains play a very important role in the Dolphin's community. One boy and one girl, 14 years or over are selected by the members (by vote) to be the captains for the coming swimming year.

### *What is being the club captain all about?*

Our Club Captains are expected to attend most Friday nights and to be positive role models for the younger members of the club. They are also expected to attend some junior carnivals throughout the season, as well as some important Dolphins events like the RSL Club Junior Sports ANZAC Ceremony.

The highlight for most of our Captains in the past has been the annual Captains' awards at our Summer Presentation. This involves an informal speech, and fun prize-giving.

## Formal description of role

### *Objective*

The role requires the Club Captain to lead the swimming members of the club in the activities of the club. Importantly the club captain will implement the requests of the club committee and support the club committee in any reasonable task requested.

- Attend, participate and contribute to the success of Friday night races and club championships
- Attend Junior carnivals and support club members
- Present captain's awards and speech at club summer championship presentation
- Attend and participate in Dolphins fun events such as: Halloween event, Easter event, Christmas event
- Represent the club at the RSL clubs Anzac Day memorial service and Anzac Day service
- Attend development squads to work with coaches and lead younger swimmers
- Assist in club activities as requested by the committee
- Be actively involved in the club and having a positive influence on the members
- Bring one new idea to the club and assist with making it happen

The club captains will be assisted and mentored by a nominated member of the committee  
At various stages during the year different club committee members will assist the club captains in their duties.
